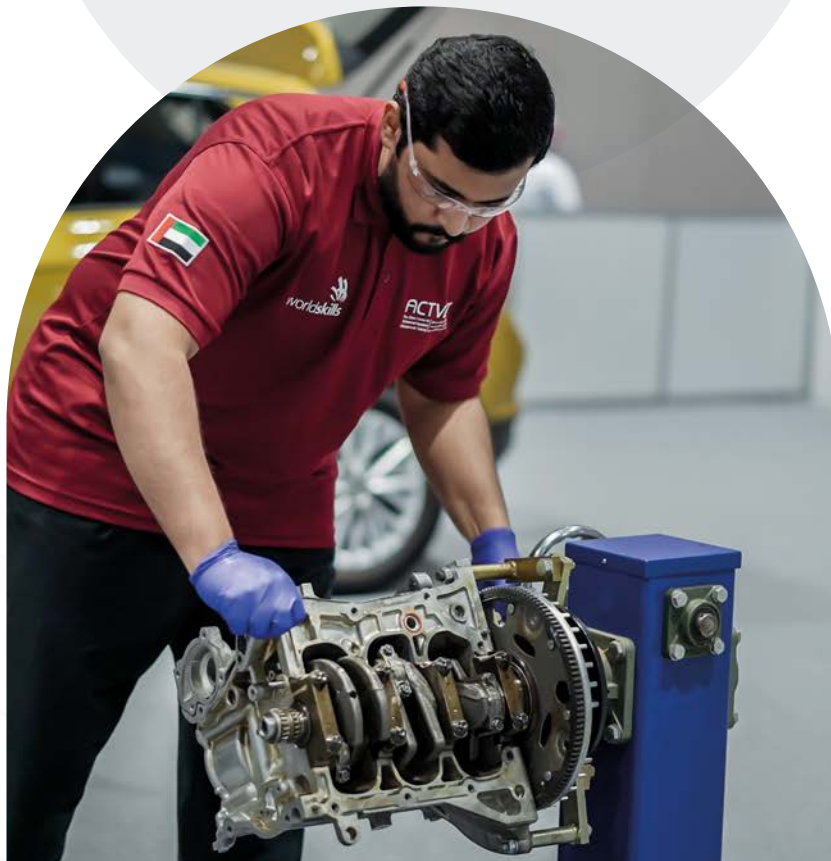

### FCCHS launches Bachelor of Science in Midwifery

FCCHS is proud to have developed the Bachelor of Science in Midwifery, 120 credit hours, four-year degree program which is the first Direct Entry Midwifery undergraduate degree in the United Arab Emirates.

The programme is fully accredited by the CAA and equips graduates with the knowledge and skills to

become competent and compassionate licensed midwives. Midwifery graduates will be empowered to work in their full scope of practice providing care for women across the perinatal journey from preconception to prenatal, labour and birth, postpartum, newborn, and infant feeding care, as well as care of the newborn.
