

EmiratesSkills National Competition 2024

Under the patronage of Her Highness Sheikha Fatima bint Mubarak, the 15th EmiratesSkills National Competition, organized by ACTVET, took place at the ADNEC from 22nd to 24th April 2024. Showcasing the talents of over 400 Emirati youth across 26 skills, the competition concluded with 72 winners awarded across gold, silver, and bronze categories.

His Highness Sheikh Khaled bin Mohamed bin Zayed, Crown Prince of Abu Dhabi, and His Highness Sheikh Theyab bin Mohammed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Chairman of Office of Development and Martyrs Families Affairs graced the occasion, highlighting the nation's commitment to nurturing talent. Additionally, the event was attended by other government officials, industry leaders, educators, and students. Competitors engaged in rigorous challenges, demonstrating expertise in diverse fields from technology to craftsmanship.

A "Friendly Skills Competition" was also held during ESNC 2024, featuring over 60 competitors from 17 countries, each demonstrating their expertise across 14 skills.

Under the Patronage of H.H. Sheikh Theyab bin Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan, Deputy Chairman of the Presidential Court for Development and Fallen Heroes' Affairs ACTVET organized the TVET Leaders Forum on 22nd April 2024, from 9 am to 11.30 am at ADNEC.

The forum featured two sessions: "Inspiring Emirati Youth," which included presentations and panel discussions by ACTVET alumni who have successfully attained leading positions in the UAE workforce, and "Apprenticeship and TVET for Sustainable Development," which included presentations and panel discussions by regional and international delegates.



Dual Healthcare Program

The Dual Healthcare Program allows high-achieving students from Applied Technology Schools across the emirates to enrol in courses at Fatima College of Health Sciences during their secondary education. These courses will be recognized as accredited hours when applying to health- related courses at Fatima College of Health Sciences

The pilot phase of the Dual Healthcare Program began in January 2024 at Applied Technology Schools. The program spans 16 weeks and offers three courses: "Fundamentals of Nursing", "Health and Wellbeing," and "Communication Skills for Healthcare Professionals", each providing 3 credited hours. These courses are taught daily at Fatima College of Health Sciences branches in Abu Dhabi, Al Ain, or Ajman after regular school days.

ACTVET partners with NAFIS

Employment of 40 UAE nationals trained at "Skills Hub"

ACTVET announced the employment of 40 UAE nationals trained at "Skills Hub", an initiative supported by the Abu Dhabi government, within 5 prestigious private healthcare companies. This announcement reflects the outcome of collaborative agreements signed between ACTVET and 5 prominent healthcare companies - Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi, M42, Burjeel Hospital, Response Plus Holding, and Cambridge Medical & Rehabilitation Center.



UAE Team participation in the "2024 Global Skills Challenge"

UAE Team participated in a four-day friendly competition – "2024 Global Skills Challenge" held in Australia from 23rd to 26th May 2024. It was designed with simulated competition to test the skills of competitors in their chosen fields. It served as rigorous preparation platform for the team, along with participants from over 19 countries, for the upcoming 47th WorldSkills International Competition in Lyon, France. With around 400 competitors, experts, and officials, it marked Australia's largest international skills event in 2024.

UAE Team, comprising 16 members, won two silver medals, notably excelling in Painting and Decorating and earning the prestigious "Best of Nation Award" for their outstanding performance.



Skills Department Team Building Sessions

The Skills Department at ACTVET conducted three team building sessions aimed at enhancing productivity and personal development of competitors.

9th Team Building - 16th May 2024

This session was focused on setting SMART goals with the competitors. This approach helped them define their goals in a specific, measurable, achievable, relevant, and time-bound manner, ensuring they were not superficial. Additionally, the competitors wrote letters to themselves, which will be given to them during the competition.

10th Team Building - 10th June 2024

In these sessions, competitors were taught the concept of "divide and conquer" to show them how to take a big and intimidating task and break it down into smaller parts to make it easier to accomplish.

11th Team Building - 26th June 2024

During this team-building session, the importance of humility for any champion was emphasized. The impact of over confidence and a lack of confidence was compared and demonstrate how humility can aid in this process.
